Fr. Ray served a number of congregations of the diocese, including St. John, Shawano; St. John, New London; St. Paul, Plymouth; St. Boniface, Chilton; Christ Church, Green Bay; St. James, Manitowoc; St. Peter, Sheboygan Falls; St. Mark, Waupaca; and All Saints, Appleton. He was active in Cursillo and served on a number of committees and commissions of the diocese.

A funeral service will be held at St. Thomas, Menasha on Wednesday, August 17 at 3:00 p.m. A time of visitation will take place at Cotter Funeral Home, De Pere from 5-7 p.m. on Tuesday, August 16 and Wednesday from 1-3 p.m. at St. Thomas.
