Tammy McVeigh will order the gift cards which you will receive a week or two after you order. You receive cards for the full value you purchased to use or give away. St. James will receive a percent from the merchants (amount varies by merchant) for offering this service. All money St. James receives from the merchants goes directly into our Outreach fund to help with outreach in our greater community.
