From Aran Walter, Associate Priest and Youth Pastor, St. Thomas Church, Menasha

Over the past 2 years, St. Thomas has partnered with Delaware North and Lambeau Field . . . and we've raised just shy of \$40,000 in the process. All 100% profit for ministry. We've used the funds to help make mission trips possible, support our international and local mission partners, and more.

We want to share the wealth . . . want to help? Here's the deal:

At every home Packers game, we serve desserts up in the luxury suites. It's climate controlled so we don't roast in the summer and don't freeze in the winter. It's a pretty amazing environment as you can imagine. Lots of fun. Lots of great people. Even a celebrity or two now and then! The desserts are on carts that we push from suite to suite. 2 people per cart and we run 7 carts on 3 levels plus we have 2 runners.

We earn \$100 per person per game. It adds up quickly. What we at St. Thomas are doing this year is reaching out to other churches in our diocese to see if there are folks who'd like to help out at a game, or 2, or more. You wouldn't need to provide volunteers for an entire game. You could send as few as ONE to a game. Or 1 or 2 or 3 to a couple of games. Or pick one game and send half a dozen. At the end of the season, St. Thomas would then write a check to **St. James for our Outreach Fund** for \$100 x however many people worked during the season. Send 4 people, earn \$400. Send 10, you've got \$1,000.

We would obviously need to know WELL in advance the names of people coming, their email addresses, and which games they'd be working at. Once they officially volunteer, we'd need them to be 100% committed.

Volunteers needs to be at least 14 years old, be able to be on their feet for several hours straight, wear black shoes, black socks, black pants (no jeans or leggings), and a smile. There's a short online quiz each volunteer MUST take and pass (we'll send the link and "study guide" directly to those who volunteer) and there are a couple of release forms to fill out as well (name, signature, etc.) but again, we'll send those out to those who volunteer.
